

# Community Information - Oaklands Precinct Upgrade Dwyer Road Reserve and Diagonal Way Notice of Works

Marion Council will begin work on the upgrade of Dwyer Rd Reserve and redevelopment of Diagonal Way in June.

The Oaklands Precinct project seeks to improve access to the area for pedestrians and cyclists and create a bigger public park with play equipment that uses the latest technology.

Diagonal Way, north of the residential properties, has been closed by the Surveyor General.

The improvements aim to make it easier for residents and visitors to access the adjacent Oaklands Crossing and Marion's entertainment and retail centre. This will benefit residents, local businesses, visitors, and commuters.

These works form part of Council's \$5 million investment in the area surrounding the Oaklands Station. This project has also received Federal Government funding of \$867,500 (Department of Infrastructure, Regional Development and Cities Building Our Future)

Construction works will be from 7am-5pm weekdays. We will advise of any changes to traffic conditions during construction. Work is expected to be completed in October 2020.

Thank you to everyone who contributed to community consultation during 2019.

Council endorsed detailed designs in February this year.

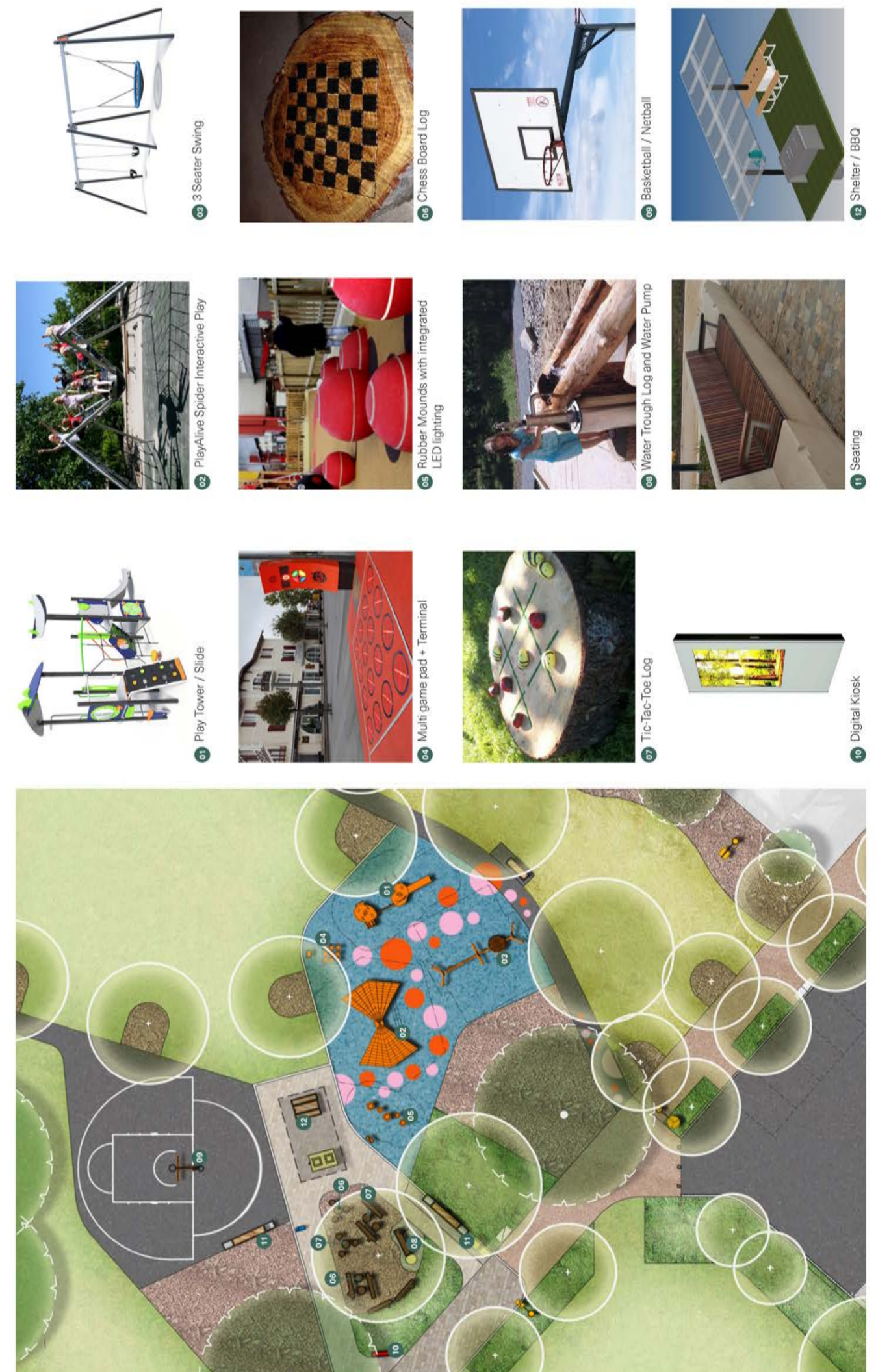
## Features of the reserve redevelopment

- New play equipment including climbing structure, slide, swings, nature play elements and interactive smart technology equipment
- 3 on 3 basketball and netball
- Enhanced pathways connections to the Oaklands Station and broader precinct
- Shelter structures with solar panels, BBQ and picnic settings and Wi-Fi
- Extensive landscaping, mature trees, irrigated turf and water sensitive urban design
- Lighting with smart sensor technology for activated dimming and energy efficiency
- Smart irrigation with weather and soil moisture sensors
- Formalised car parking with increased on street capacity
- Wayfinding information and public art
