

The Domain Theatre is the centre's 'performing art' focus hosting a diverse range of activities including, performing arts, functions, meetings, seminars, concerts and conferences.

The contemporary, unique, intimate, multi-purpose design of the Domain Theatre creates a wonderful sensory audience experience.

Adaptable to a wide range of configurations, the Domain Theatre and its versatile seating area facility provides an excellent venue for a wide range of 'performance-based' activities ranging from theatrical or musical performance to product launches, banquets, film screenings, seminars, meetings and conferences.

The theatre space incorporates a raised movable stage for theatrical and musical performances. Internal finishes of sprung timber over a concrete slab and acoustic wall panelling and multi-purpose subsidiary spaces including, a backstage area and rehearsal space, means the Domain Theatre can meet the requirements for large or small productions.

The Theatre has a flexible flat floor space plus a in-house audio visual system and large retractable cinema screen ideal for multiple uses i.e.: theatre, music, expert speakers, product/book launch, exhibitions or ceremonies.

The Green room is included in function hire which can be used as a breakout room which can be divided into two small dressing rooms, direct access to back stage theatre.

Equipped with sinks, mirrors, cupboards and an iron for costumes. Ideal configuration 255 audience with 8m x 5m stage area and 1m wing spaces. Includes technician in room hire. Box office facilities and front of house services also available, pricing upon application.


the green room




