CITY OF MARION BUILDING FIRE SAFETY COMMITTEE INSPECTION POLICY



This inspection policy relates to existing buildings. The policy specifies the classes of building to be inspected and criteria that apply to the selection of the buildings.

- 1 An inspection of a building will be carried out when;
 - A complaint is received;
 - The South Australian Metropolitan Fire Service requests that an inspection be carried out;
 - Advice from a Development Officer Building of Council is received of fire safety deficiencies;
 and
 - The class of building fits with the priorities of the Building Fire Safety Committee Inspection Policy.
- 2 The inspection priorities of the Building Fire Safety Committee are related to types of buildings with high potential for fire safety risk as follows;
 - Hotels / Motels;
 - Caravan Parks and Supported Residential Facilities;
 - Class 9b buildings;
 - Class 6, 7 and 8 buildings
- 3 Fire safety deficiencies of a minor nature will be dealt with by a Development Officer Building of Council who holds prescribed qualifications and is directed to undertake inspections of buildings under Section 71(1) of the Act by the Building Fire Safety Committee.
