Marion Business Hub at the City of Marion is hosting guided [walking tours](#) of Tonsley, Australia's first business innovation district.

The Tonsley Innovation District is a unique development in the City of Marion.

The former Mitsubishi Motors assembly plant at Tonsley is in the process of being completely redeveloped as an integrated employment, education, and residential precinct by Renewal SA.

The Marion Business Hub walking tours are an opportunity to find out how the Tonsley mixed-use precinct design is supporting businesses wanting to innovate, grow, go global and move up the value chain.
