Biggest twilight street party in Marion

Thousands of revellers are expected to party in the street when the curtain rises on Marion's biggest, free community festival tomorrow (Saturday, 25 March).

Marion Celebrates will be a twilight street party featuring multicultural music and dance, food trucks, an art project, open air market, and entertainment for kids.

This is the 10th Marion Celebrates, which is a biennial event, and the first of its type as a street party.

The event includes a five-hour stage show of live music ranging from Latin funk to Flamenco and contemporary Japanese dance.

Free family entertainment includes a contortionist, unicyclist, roving choir and native animal display.
