

Castle Plaza parking zones

Vicinity Centres has requested the City of Marion to assist in addressing concerns over parking at Castle Plaza, Edwardstown.

The Centre Management has observed that, while the parking zones at Castle Plaza are designed to cater to valued shoppers and customers, there have been instances where commuters and employees of external businesses are occupying these designated spaces.

Vicinity Centres states, "We are committed to ensuring a seamless shopping experience for our patrons. Dedicated spaces for our customers are at the heart of this commitment."

To provide clarity:

- The general parking at Castle Plaza allows for a 4-hour stay.
- The 15-minute zones have been created specifically for brief tasks such as accessing ATMs.
- Disability parking spaces are strictly reserved for those customers who need them. We jointly appeal to everyone to ensure these spaces remain available for their intended users.

In a collective effort, monitoring of parking at Castle Plaza will commence in September 2023. City of Marion's Community Safety Inspectors are authorised to uphold the parking legislation in the area, ensuring that all parking zones are used as intended.

We greatly value the cooperation and understanding of the public on this matter and urge everyone to adhere to the designated parking rules, ensuring Castle Plaza remains a welcoming destination for all.
