Project Background

Consultation for the overall plan for Capella Reserve was undertaken in October 2019. A pre-design consultation to help design the skate park was undertaken in August 2020.

Consultation on the draft concept occurred in September / October 2020, including a drop in session at the reserve. Final community feedback was received on the revised design in November 2020.

Skatepark and Carpark Works

Council has received matching funding from the Federal Government's Local Roads and Community Infrastructure program to construct the skate park.

This stage of construction will include:

- New skatepark with lighting
- New expanded car park
- 3 v 3 basketball court
- Climbing elements
- Shelter, seating, drinking fountain.
