Project Update & Notice of Works



TROTT PARK TRAIL

A trail will be constructed to link the following four Reserves:

- Tyson Avenue Reserve
- Reserve Street Reserve
- Scarvell Avenue Reserve
- Klippel Avenue Reserve

In September 2023, the City of Marion consulted with residents on their preferred option for the trail.

Residents preferred Option 1:

- A longer trail, running the whole length of Tyson Avenue Reserve and connecting to the dog park entry near Rix Court
- New bench seats
- Increased tree and native planting

The construction industry is busy at the moment, so securing a contractor has taken time but we are pleased to announce construction will begin **18 March 2024**. Works are expected to be complete **May 2024**.

Please note that infill plantings in the existing garden beds surrounding the Reserve Street Reserve playground will be planted in addition to the trail works.


