

Option 1: TRAIL ONLY

The proposed trail (1.2km return) connects 4 reserves within Trott Park providing an opportunity for active recreation and more direct access to facilities at Reserve Street Reserve.

Tyson Ave Reserve

Trail features include:

- A new 1.5m wide unsealed path connecting four reserves from Klippel Ave Reserve to Tyson Ave Reserve.
- Potential new kerb ramps at road crossing points.
- Wayfinding markers with directional arrows and distance markers.

Option 1 specific trail features include:

- A longer trail than Option 2, running through the whole length of Tyson Ave Reserve and connecting to the eastern dog park entry near
- 4 x New bench seats to increase rest stops along trail.
- Increased tree and native planting along the trail to increase natural shade, amenity and biodiversity.

Note: The budget for Option 1 and Option 2 are the same
