Westall Way Reserve Upgrade Project Update & Notice of Works



Westall Way Reserve Open space upgrade

Westall Way Reserve, Sheidow Park is a local level playground which is scheduled in the Playground Framework to be upgraded. In September 2020 the City of Marion consulted with residents on the open space upgrade at the Westall Way Reserve. After incorporating resident feedback, the design for the reserve was finalised.

The construction works are due to commence in the week of <u>12th April 2021</u> which includes removal of existing playground equipment. Outside Ideas will be undertaking the construction works.

DESIGN

The design for the reserve includes:

- · Butterfly garden- native plants
- Nature-based play Timber balance beams, Boulders
- Outdoor classroom- Timber stage, blackboard
- Interpretive signage, Sun catcher and sensory path
- Improved pavements, bench seats, drinking fountain and rubbish bin
- Irrigated turf and general landscaping
