

## PRECEDENT IMAGES



The City of Marion, in partnership with the Federal Government will undertake a selective upgrade to Mema Court Reserve in Hallett Cove. The project is based on a 2022 Federal Election commitment.

Planning and design will be undertaken in the 22/23 financial year, with construction to be undertaken in the 23/24 year.

Community consultation was conducted in late 2022, which included an online survey and on-site consultation session. Council has consolidated community feedback and presented preferred elements in a final concept plan. Council will commence detailed design upon final endorsement of this proposed Concept. Final design outcome is subject to competitive tender process, market conditions and council internal approvals.
