#### **HANDY HINTS**

Test your graffiti remover on a small area of the graffiti you wish to remove first.

If you can not remove a few square centimetres, then you will not be able to remove several square meters. Up to 60% of graffiti removal from painted surfaces requires the area to be repainted.

Be sure when removing graffiti by the 'paint out' method that you match your colours/s as near as possible to the **original** colour of the surface.
