

INSTRUMENT OF SUBDELEGATION

- 1. In exercise of the power contained in Section 100 of the Planning, Development and Infrastructure Act 2016 the powers and functions under the Planning, Development and Infrastructure Act 2016 and statutory instruments made thereunder contained in the proposed *Instrument of Delegation* attached and marked *Attachment 1* are hereby delegated this 28 November 2022 to the person occupying the position of Assessment Manager, subject to the conditions and/or limitations, if any, specified herein or in the Schedule of Conditions in the proposed Instrument of Delegation.
- 2. The powers and functions so delegated are set out in *Instrument D Instrument Of Delegation Under The Planning, Development And Infrastructure Act 2016, Planning, Development And Infrastructure (General) Regulations 2017 And Planning, Development And Infrastructure (Fees, Charges And Contributions) Regulations 2019 Of Powers Of An Assessment Manager.*
- 3. The Council Assessment Managers holds powers and functions (identified in Schedule of Delegations Instrument D) pursuant to;

- 4. In exercise of the powers under Section 100(2)(c) of the *Planning, Development and Infrastructure Act 2016* I, as Assessment Manager, hereby:
 - 4.1. sub-delegate such of those powers and functions identified in the Head Delegation as are specified below to the person holding the positions specified below, on the terms and conditions specified below.
- 5. The sub-delegated powers and functions may be exercised individually be each sub-delegate in respect of any particular matter where the sub-delegate is required or proposing to act in the course of their duties.
