## 39 Forever

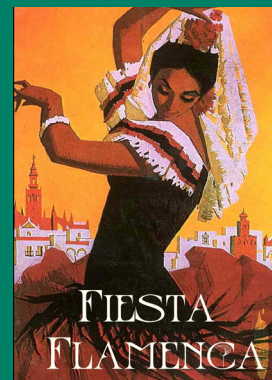
