I am three years old! Is it time to think about preschool?

Your child is entitled to access one year of Government kindergarten (preschool). If your child turns 4 before 1st May, they can start kindergarten at the beginning of the year. If your child turns 4 on or after 1st May, they can start the next year.



You must register your interest to every government kindergarten you are looking at. You can register at any time of year but you should submit a registration of interest form to the preschool by 30 June in the year before your child is due to start.

You can do this online at https://www.education.sa.gov.au/doc/preschool-registration-interest-form or obtain this form from the kindergarten.


