

Register of Conflicts Interests



Actual or Perceived Conflicts of Interest

Under Section 75A (4) If a member of a council discloses an actual or perceived conflict of interest in a matter to be discussed at a meeting of the council, the following details must be recorded in the minutes of the meeting and on a website determined by the chief executive officer:

- (a) the member's name;
- (b) the nature of the interest, as described by the member;
- (c) the manner in which the member dealt with the actual or perceived conflict of interest;
- (d) if the member voted on the matter, the manner in which he or she voted;
- (e) the manner in which the majority of persons who were entitled to vote at the meeting voted on the matter.

Material Conflicts of Interest

Under section 74(5) of the Local Government Act 1999, If a member of a council discloses a material conflict of interest in a matter to be discussed at a meeting of the council, the following details must be recorded in the minutes of the meeting and on a website determined by the chief executive officer:

- a) the member's name;
- b) the nature of the interest, as described by the member;
- c) if the member took part in the meeting, or was in the chamber during the meeting, under an approval under subsection (3), the fact that the member took part in the meeting, or was in the chamber during the meeting (as the case requires)."
